

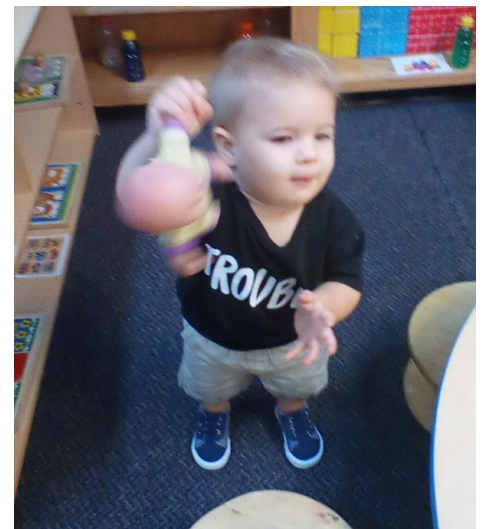
# September 2020
